I thought that this was the best organized of the core courses from the first year of the program so far. Matt had a clear idea of what material he wanted to cover and how he wanted us to internalize that material, and the course was organized accordingly. I think that some of the earlier homework assignments may have felt a bit disconnected from the material we were covering in lecture at the time, but the relevance became clear as we proceeded through the

Matt was great at being very clear what he expected from us, then following up with it and actually staying true to what he said. He was also great at adjusting his assignments according to where our class lectures and readings took the content that was covered.

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Hard to gauge what math needs to be taught. Some subjects certain students were far more familiar with over others.

Next year, there will be fewer typos on the slides. I also would appreciate a script from the professor with interpretations after each homework assignment. I was new to STATA and would have liked to see exactly he tackled these problems (so I could shamelessly steal his tricks). He walked through it once in class, but I would have appreciated a concise "completed homework" as if he was turning it in.

I thought this was the most interactive and engaging course that I've taken virtually this year. Matt's teaching style and his willingness to cold-call on students incentivizes participation and attentiveness, and I hope he continues to carry that style forward as we return to campus in the coming schoolyear.

This is more for the TA sessions, but I feel like it might have been more helpful if they really dived into the meat of the class and pretty much only do demonstrations in STATA/R rather than basically doing repeats of the lectures.
